



Southeastern Adams Volunteer Emergency Services Sportsman's Bingo Rules



1. All attendees must have a ticket to play and must be at least 18 years old. No non-players allowed.
2. All players must have valid photo identification with them during the event and to claim any prizes.
3. NO PRIVATE FIREARMS PERMITTED ON PREMISES.
4. A minimum of 260 tickets must be sold for the event to take place. SAVES reserves the right to cancel the event for any reason by refunding the cost of any tickets already sold. Announcement of such cancellation will be made prior to the day of the event on the SAVES website and Facebook page.
5. The minimum ticket package is 9 cards for each of 25 games. Additional card packs may be purchased for \$5 for 3 additional cards. All ticket packs include participation in all bingo games.
6. One meal per ticket holder is also included in the base ticket price. Additional food items may be purchased à la carte.
7. Any prizes advertised for a particular event are for illustrative purposes only and are not guaranteed; however, every effort will be made to advertise accurate prize information. SAVES reserves the right to substitute prizes of a comparable value at its sole discretion.
8. Prizes may be claimed by the bingo winner only. There are no cash options available for any prize offered unless expressly stated otherwise.
9. Firearm prizes may be claimed during the event by visiting the Gettysburg Trading Post table or by visiting their store (2222 York Rd, Gettysburg, PA 17325) after the event. Archery prizes must be claimed by visiting the Marchio's Sport Hut store (1245 High St, Hanover, PA 17331) after the event. All prizes must be claimed within 30 days of winning or will be forfeited.
10. Prize winners must pass any applicable background check(s) as required by law or the vendor. Failure of the prize winner to successfully complete required checks will result in an alternate award of a \$150 gift certificate to the applicable vendor. There are no cash options available for any prize offered unless specifically stated otherwise.
11. If any winner of a handgun special is under 21 years old (the legal age to purchase/register a handgun), they will be awarded an alternate prize of a gift certificate to Gettysburg Trading Post for an amount equal to SAVES' cost for the prize handgun. The designation of an alternate prize claimant will not be allowed.
12. Prizes will be awarded to a single winner only. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be utilized to determine the final winner. Each player involved in the tie will be assigned a SAVES representative to monitor and assist the player in the tie-break process.
 - a. All games except the final, fill-the-card special:
 - i. The next ball will be drawn, shown in the camera, and announced in play.
 - ii. If any tied players have the called number on their winning card, then all tied players who do not have the number will be eliminated. If no tied players have the number, then all tied players continue.
 - iii. The above process will be repeated until a single winner remains. All players originally tied who do not win the game prize will be entered into a consolation prize drawing for the event half in which the tie occurred (i.e., first half and second half).
 - iv. If during the tie-break process all remaining tied players have duplicate cards (as determined by the number in the center Free Space of the winning card), the final, fill-the-card special tie-break process will be used to determine the final winner from among the remaining tied winners.
 - b. The final, filled-the-card special:
 - i. All tied winners will be issued a single, uniquely numbered empty bingo card.
 - ii. All previously called balls will be dumped back into the ball hopper.
 - iii. A ball will be drawn, shown in the camera, and announced in play.
 - iv. If any tied players have the called number on their card, then all tied players who do not have the number will be eliminated. If no tied players have the number, then all tied players continue.
 - v. The above process will be repeated until a single winner remains. All players originally tied who do not win the game prize will be entered into a consolation prize drawing for the event half in which the tie occurred (i.e., first half and second half).

13. All regular games of bingo may be won with straight bingo only (i.e., vertical, horizontal, and diagonal). All special games of bingo may be won with the announced pattern only. All winning patterns for a particular game will be displayed on the bingo boards at each end of the hall.
14. Bingo balls are displayed on the televisions prior to being announced as a courtesy to assist players. **Numbers are not in-play until they are announced by the bingo caller.**
15. Players may only win bingo if the last number called by the announcer is part of the winning pattern.
16. Players with bingo should announce their bingo loudly and raise their hand to attract the attention of the bingo caller or another SAVES representative before the next number is announced. All acknowledged bingos will be announced by the bingo caller. Should the next number be announced before the bingo is acknowledged, any previous winning patterns will be invalid, since they will no longer include the most recent number called. **SAVES is not responsible for a player's failure to attract the attention of a SAVES representative before the next bingo number is called**, thereby invalidating their winning bingo pattern.
17. Smoking is only permitted in designated areas outside of the main entrance.
18. An ATM is available in the coat room off of the main entrance lobby.
